It is made up of a series of practical workshops designed to enable leaders to deliver care in line with the expectations of a 'Well-led' service.

You'll find out what managers of well-led organisations do to achieve and sustain high standards and how to apply these examples across your own organisation to deliver high quality, person-centred care. Throughout the programme you will be supported to develop your leadership skills, advance your service and have a real impact in your workplace in order to secure a well-led future.

The Well-led programme is a national initiative offering a package of support and development over a three month period which includes:

- four interactive workshop sessions exploring live issues, challenges and practical examples of being well-led
- peer support and networking opportunities for you to connect with, and learn from, other managers in the social care sector
- access to Skills for Care's resources and tools for practical application in your workplace
- a programme certificate of completion and membership of the Skills for Care alumni.
